Dear Parent/Guardian of 12th Grade Students:

The MacArthur Guidance and Counseling Department is pleased to inform you that we will be hosting the On-Site Admissions Program with some of the colleges in our area. This year, admissions counselors will meet in person to conduct interviews and review application files to grant admission into their college or university on the spot. **Application fees will be waived** for all students who participate.


On the reverse side of this sheet you will find a list of schools that will be taking part in this event as well as each college's specific requirements for On-Site Admissions.

Please be aware of the following:

- Students who do not meet the requirements for a specific college may submit the completed application by the deadline and get the fee waived, however those students will not get an On-Site appointment.
- Please review the chart carefully as some institutions are unable to make decisions during On-Site for select majors.
- Students who are unable to make their appointment on the posted day for any reason (field trip/absence/etc.) can submit their application ahead of time and get the fee waived. However, the colleges will only be meeting with students on the posted days. If a student cannot make their allotted time slot, please check with your counselor to see if the appointment can be changed.
- It is the student's responsibility to make sure their On-Site application is complete. **Only those students who have submitted applications AND returned a completed green online application form to the guidance office by the deadline** will be given a scheduled appointment time to meet with the college admissions representative.
