


Ms. Dunbar's class crushed their I-Ready lessons and celebrated with a root beer float party! Hard work pays off!!


Ms. Vrachnas' 5th grade class, students creatively explore geometry by crafting their names using various shapes, showcasing their imagination and understanding of geometric concepts.
