



Middle School Summer Program

- Goal
 - Bridge learning gaps to provide opportunities for success
- Target population
 - Students who fail ELA or Math
- Supporting Data
 - Approximately 49% of the students who failed ELA or Math in 2011/12 failed again in 2012/13
- Structure
 - 5 weeks, 3days/week for 90 min. per subject
- Cost
 - \$15,000
