#### III. ACTION ITEMS: OLD BUSINESS.

 MOTION: Mr. Moran moved, "WHEREAS, the unprecedented effects of Hurricane Sandy Caused the closure of school for five days and; RESOLUTION #12-13-111 Revised 2012-2013 School Calendar

WHEREAS, a subsequent nor'easter caused the closure of school for one additional day; and

WHEREAS, these school closures have caused a shortage in required student and teacher attendance days;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in order to meet the required student and teacher attendance days, the Levittown Board of Education does, hereby, approve the attached revised school calendar for the 2012-2013 school year.

Seconded: Mr. Powers

NOTE: Dr. Grossane explained that he is proposing to amend the 2012-2013 school calendar to include the Wednesday February 20, Thursday February 21 and Friday February 22 of the Winter Break due to the unprecedented loss of school time. He noted the district needs to meet the minimum mandate of school days, 180 days of session, in order to receive the full complement of state aid. More importantly, we need to insure continuity of instruction for our students. Dr. Grossane noted these dates provide us with a solid block of time and it affords us to still pay our due respects to the national holidays. Mr. Pappas commented that a lot of people are talking about waiting for a waiver from the state but you have to exhaust all of your vacation days before you could receive that. Mr. Pappas stated that while it is unpleasant for anyone to lose vacation time, Levittown is in a much better position than many school districts due to Dr. Grossane's leadership in getting the buildings operational quickly.
