President's Report (Sue Massoni)

- Resolutions packet was posted and sent to everyone. Looking for a vote of confidence to present resolutions at convention.

• All students were invited to join the guidance google classroom. They should check this classroom regularly as it is updated daily with pertinent information. Freshman students were invited to fill out a meet and greet questionnaire. Please encourage your student to fill out the form if they have not already done so. College information night will be extended to parents of sophomore students in addition to junior parents. Senior parent information regarding upcoming college fairs has been posted to the guidance google classrooms for juniors and seniors. College information night will be held Tues. Oct. 27 at 7pm on Zoom. Seniors are also invited to sign up for college application boot camps to be held in the computer lab throughout the fall. Students should email their counselors for appointments. Students taking AP exams in May should pay no later than Mon. Nov 9.

Principal's Report (Mr. Coscia)

- We have 4 students who were recognized as commended students for their achievement and performance on the PSAT's by the National Merit Scholarship program. 2 of them were also named National Hispanic Recognition Scholars for their outstanding performance as well.
- Some DAHS students created a non-profit organization called Patterns for Patients.
 Their mission is to bring joy to pediatric patients by delivering care packages including
 home made bracelets, stickers, toys, masks, etc. They are selling bracelets to raise
 funds to put packages together. For October they have a special breast cancer
 awareness project where they are selling bracelets to raise awareness. All proceeds will
 go to breast cancer research foundation. These students have already donated to 3
 hospitals and gotten positive feedback from them.

- One of our students is a finalist in the positive coaches alliance scholarship competition and another has been chosen for NYSSMA's virtual all state concert as part of the string orchestra.
- Congrats to class officers elected.
- We have a new broadcast club.
- Our tennis courts are near completion and are looking great.
- Very proud of how the teachers have adapted to this new way of teaching.
