Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

The Levittown School District is excited to announce that we are participating in a voluntary reading program, *Read to Succeed*, which encourages students in grades K to 6 to read for fun! *Read to Succeed* is a free program sponsored by Six Flags Theme Parks. Every student who completes at least six hours of recreational reading before the deadline of **February 26, 2016**, is eligible for a free admission ticket valid at one Six Flags Theme Park. We believe a district-wide reading program that emphasizes recreational reading will allow our students to explore and appreciate the value of reading in their lives.

Read to Succeed Six Flags Theme Park Guidelines:

- Only students in grades K through 6 are eligible to participate.
- Review the attached reading log. Your child will use this log to record what and how long he/she reads.
- You must initial the log as verification that your child has completed the logged record. You must also sign the log prior to returning it to the teacher.
- Your child must complete six hours or 360 minutes of recreational reading to receive a free admissions ticket to the park.
- Your child can read books, magazines, newspapers or comic books (digital or hard copy).
- Assigned reading homework **will not be counted** towards this program.
- You can read along with your child, read to your child or have your child read to you.
- Please remind your child that the reading log must be returned to his/her teacher by **February 26, 2016 due date**.

Tickets

- Tickets will be awarded to students by their teacher.
- The ticket is valid for admission to one *Six Flags Theme Parks* on select dates only during the 2016 season. Valid dates will be printed on the tickets.
- Tickets are valid for students in grades K-6 only and are not valid for anyone over the age of 13.
- Each ticket is valid for one free admission only.
- Tickets are not for resale and are not transferable.
- Tickets cannot be replaced if lost, stolen or damaged.
