- 5. Increase awareness of art in relation to other areas of the school curriculum
- 6. Bring art to the attention of the school and community
- 7. Further aesthetic awareness in all aspects of the school's total program

In order to be considered for the National Art Honor Society you must meet certain criteria which are:

Art average of 90 or better
Academic average of 80 or better
Intention to enroll in at least one art class per year
