We use the term “free money” to describe what we are earning, because if not for our collection program, box tops would just be thrown into the garbage along with the rest of the product packaging. Here’s how the program works:

Box Tops for Education is run by the General Mills Company (www.boxtops4education.com) and many of their participating products bear the \$.10 pink box top coupon.

We run our collection program as a contest through the homerooms. Students (or parents) clip the box top off the product and the student brings them to his/her homeroom teacher. The homeroom that collects the most box tops for each Quarter, wins a prize! The collected box tops are then sorted, counted and submitted twice a year. Salk receives a check in both December and June for the amount of box tops submitted.
