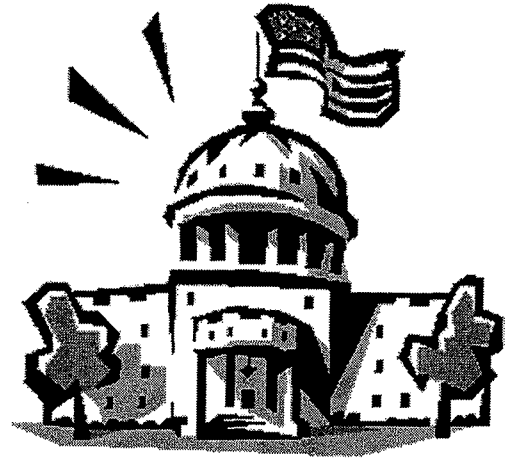

## What should I pack?

### Check Weather - Dress Appropriately

- Dress Code - applies like a school day. - Students not dressed properly entering the building will be asked to change. If a student does not comply they will not be allowed to board the bus.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

As of the date of this letter, your child has \_\_\_\_\_ point(s) for the 2018/19 school year. Once a student reaches more than six points, they will be unable to attend their grade level overnight trip dances. In addition, eighth grade students who earn more than ten points will not be allowed to attend their Zachary/Aura dance and sixth and seventh grade students will not be allowed to attend their grade level picnics.

Please view the *Point System* explanation below. This explanation can also be viewed in the student agenda book under the **Student Behavioral Code**.

Point system:

Out of School Suspension of 3 - 5 days =	9 points
Out of School Suspension of 1 - 2 days =	7 points
In School Suspension of 2 - 5 days =	4 points
In School Suspension of 1 day =	3 points
Detention of 3 - 5 days =	2 points
Detention of 1 - 2 days =	1 point
Lunch detention =	.5 of a point

Students will have the opportunity to earn back 1 point for each month that they do not receive any disciplinary action. Points will be calculated at the end of October, January, March, April, and May.
