Library Guidelines and Rules

The library is open every day from 7:45am to 3:45pm.

Students may visit the library during work study periods, lunch, teacher scheduled visits, and after school.

Students may borrow a maximum of 2 books for a 2 week period and renew a book as long as no other student or staff member has requested the book.

Overdue fines are not collected but students are unable to check out any other books until the overdue books are returned.

Students are responsible for the replacement cost of a lost or damaged book.

The library offers both print and digital information and encourages users to be respectful of all materials in the library. Students and staff may use the library for research, studying, and reading.
