## Procedures for Scheduling

## Scheduling Time Line

- November - Freshman meeting's begin to discuss plan of study
- December - February - Guidance counselors \& student meetings
- February All course requests entered into Power school, parent portal open to verify schedule.
- March $2^{\text {nd }}-4^{\text {th }}$ Students section request report is run and district determines how many section of each course will be offered
- March $6^{\text {th }}$ - Deadline for parents/students to make changes to course requests
- March $5^{\text {th }}-13^{\text {th }}$ Staffing meetings to determine staffing for each building
- Late March - Guidance chairs meet with Power school consultant to begin the "Prepare to Load" process
- April - May - Guidance chairs will continue to refine the schedule. Guidance counselors will address individual student conflicts
- June ${ }^{8 t h}$ Letters sent home with actual courses received.
- Early July - Guidance chairs commit schedule prior to end of year process.
