


Levittown Students excel in Interscholastic Athletics

A Historical Perspective



Health, Physical Education and Athletics Budget



Highlights

- Total budget is \$1,611,696
 representing an increase of \$77,563
 or 5.06%.
- Equipment increases include new equipment in the weight rooms and replacement of AEDs and Health testing trees (measures vital signs)
- BOCES fees are estimated at a 10.65% increase (health services and game officials). These will be finalized as information becomes available.

2016-2017 Initiatives

- Refresh cycle: For the 16/17 year, continue to cycle in new uniforms for many of our Middle School and High School Teams.
- Officials' fees based on estimated increase of BOCES costs but will be adjusted when final costs are determined.
- BOCES fees for Health Services was increased to coincide with the actual costs incurred in 2014-2015.
- New AEDs and Assessment Trees are scheduled to replace outdated equipment in nurses' offices.
- \$25,000 budgeted for weight room equipment.
- Funds budgeted for mats for cheerleading and wrestling.
