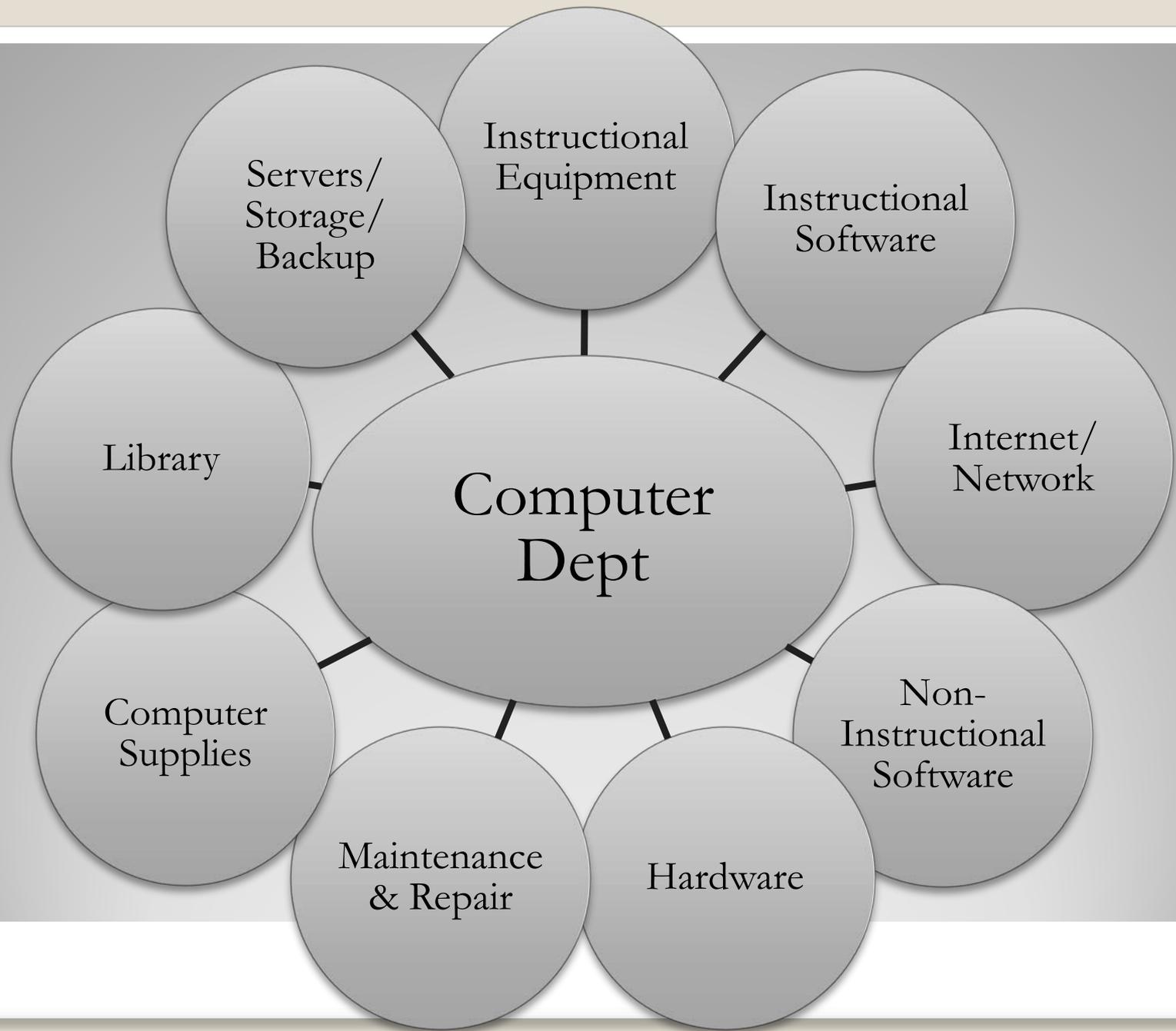

Budget Development

- Equipment refresh cycles
- Maintenance/repair
- Renewal of district software licenses
- Increased demand for online subscription software (Math IXL, Reading A-Z, etc.)
- State Mandates (i.e. online testing)
- Access to computer resources
- Smart Schools Bond Funding

Technology in Action



Equipment Refresh

- Desktop PC's average 7 yrs
 - 760's/780's, 6-7 yrs old; 208 in use
- Laptops average 5-6 yrs
 - Replace oldest used on carts
- iPads expect 5 yrs
 - Average 3.5 yrs old
- SmartBoards expect 6-7 yrs
 - Majority 4 yrs old
- Projectors expect 5-6 yrs, (some are 8-9 yrs old)
 - Replaced as needed
- Servers are mixed ages
 - Average 6 yrs, sometimes longer

Equipment Refresh

- **Printers mixed ages, smaller units avg 8 yrs**
 - Replaced as needed
- **HP core & edge switches expect 7-8 yrs**
 - 4 yrs old
- **Cisco Firewall**
 - 8 yrs old- has been deemed EOL
- **Cisco Internet & email filter expire 2018**
 - 8 yrs old
- **WiFi equipment expect 6-7 yrs**
 - 4 yrs old

Smart Schools Bond Act

- **Approved by NYS voters in Nov. 2014**
- **\$2 billion dollars state-wide**
 - **Improve Educational Technology & Infrastructure**
 - **Levittown allocated \$4,969,070**
- **Money does not have to be spent all in one year; no expiration**
- **Plan can be added to and amended**
- **Cannot double dip; no aid/purchases through BOCES**
- **Reimbursement same school year**

Smart Schools Bond Act

- **Examples of Allowable Expenditures**
 - Classroom technology- computers, tablets, laptops, whiteboards, servers
 - School Connectivity- network infrastructure upgrades, WiFi
- **Examples of Non-Allowable Expenditures**
 - Subscriptions Services
 - Software purchases
 - Professional Development
 - Support Staff

Smart Schools Bond Act

- Internet Requirement- 100 Mb per 1,000 students; 700-750 Mb's, currently 200 Mb (expenditure not covered)
- Loan requirement to non-public schools (within Levittown District boundaries)
 - Not limited to just Levittown residents
 - Amount based on enrollment
 - Two schools, The Elijah School and Maria Montessori School

- **Proposed plan (3 yr)**
 - Tablets for 1:1 Initiative
 - Laptop carts for Computer Based Testing (NYS Assessments)
 - Firewall
 - Network 10Gb upgrade

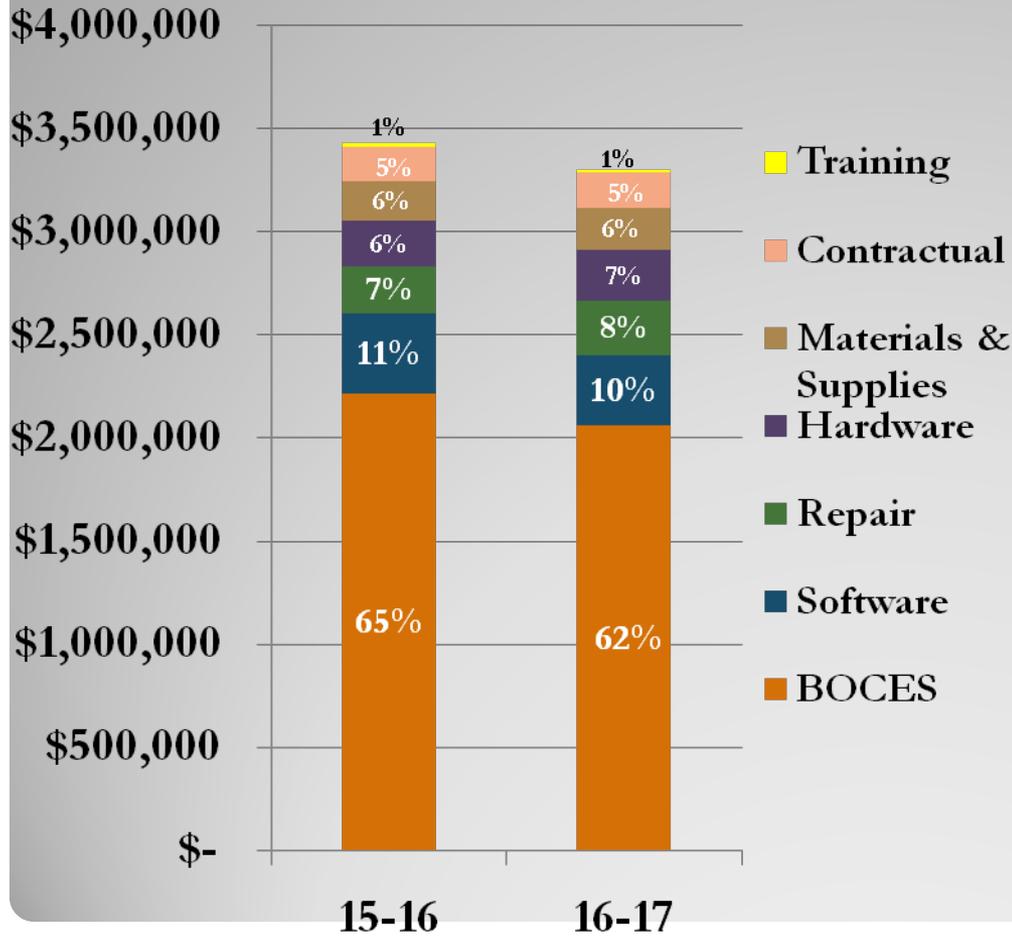

- Upgrade Engineering Room 323 at Division Ave

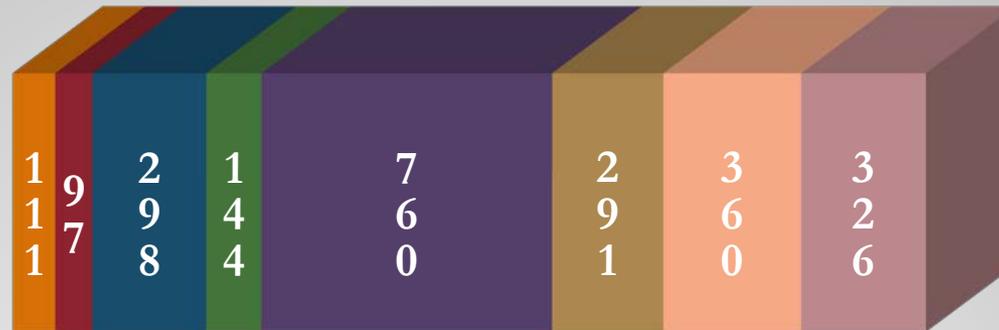

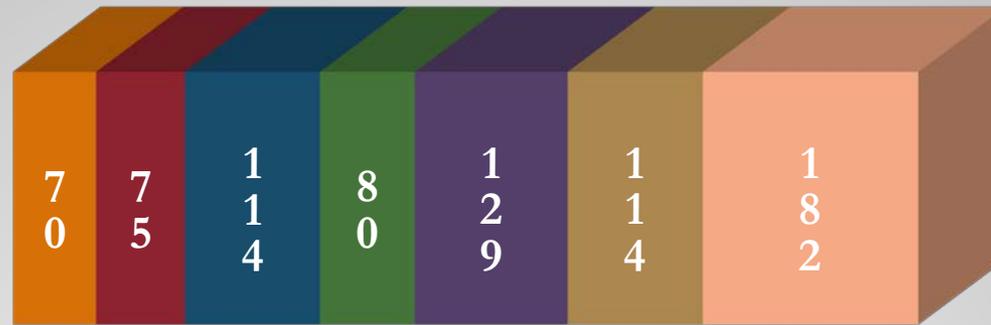

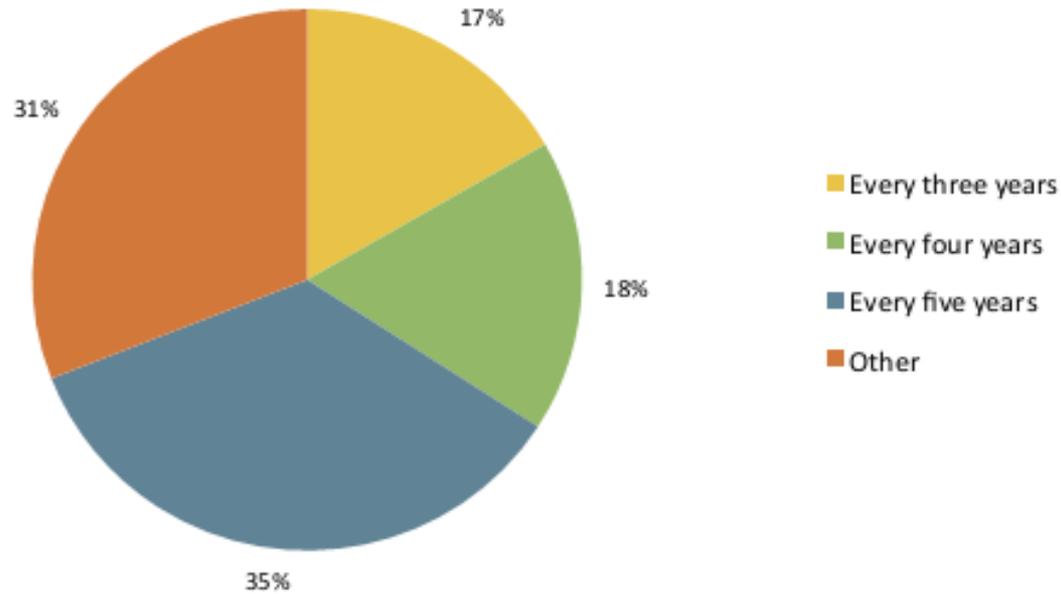

“Other” responses included:

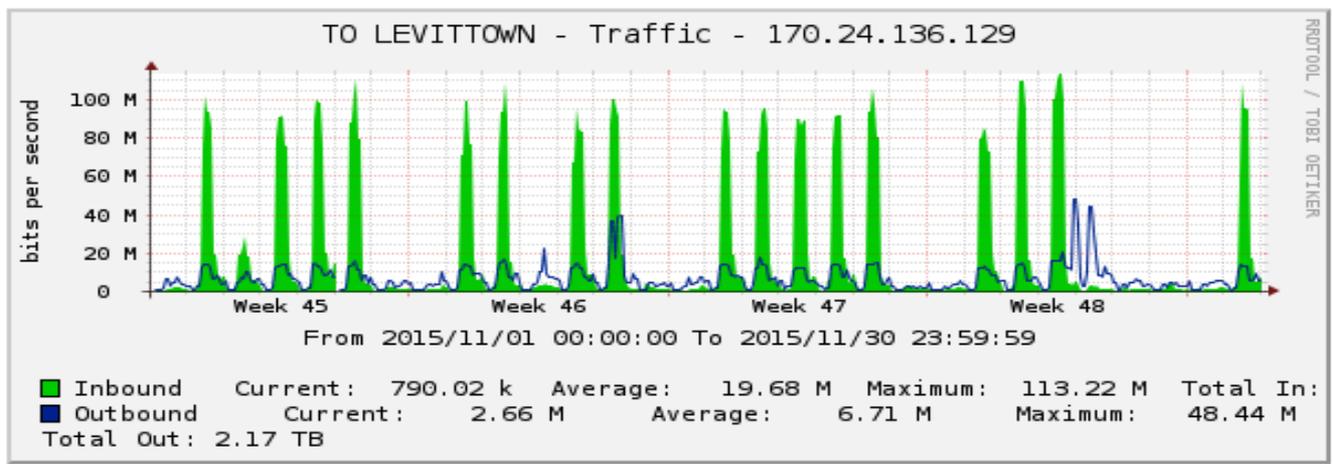
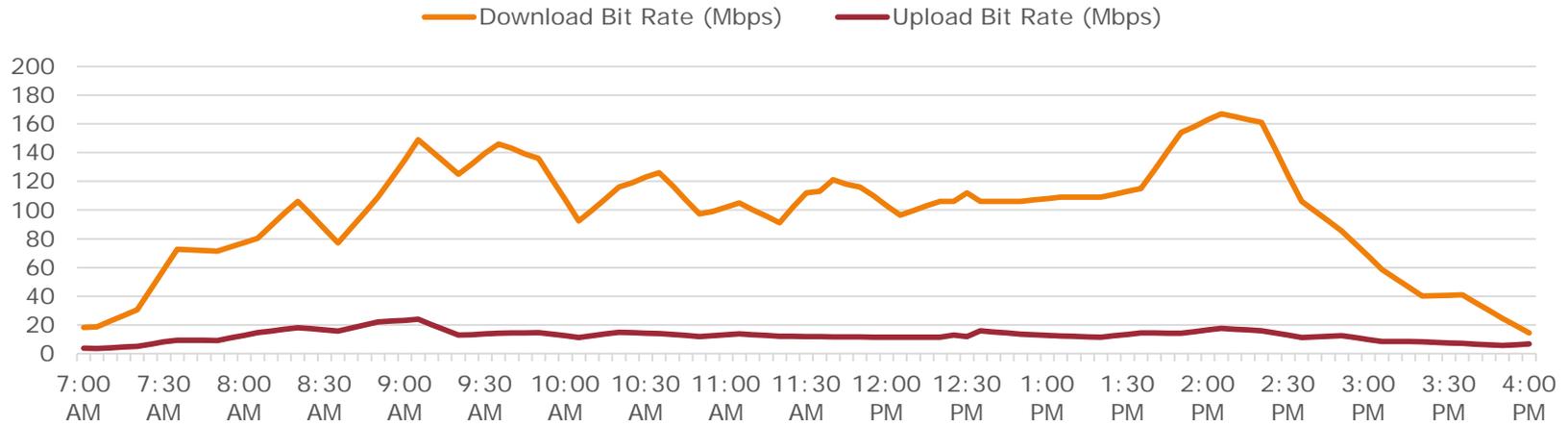
- Every two to three years

BANDWIDTH UTILIZATION - DECEMBER 11, 2015

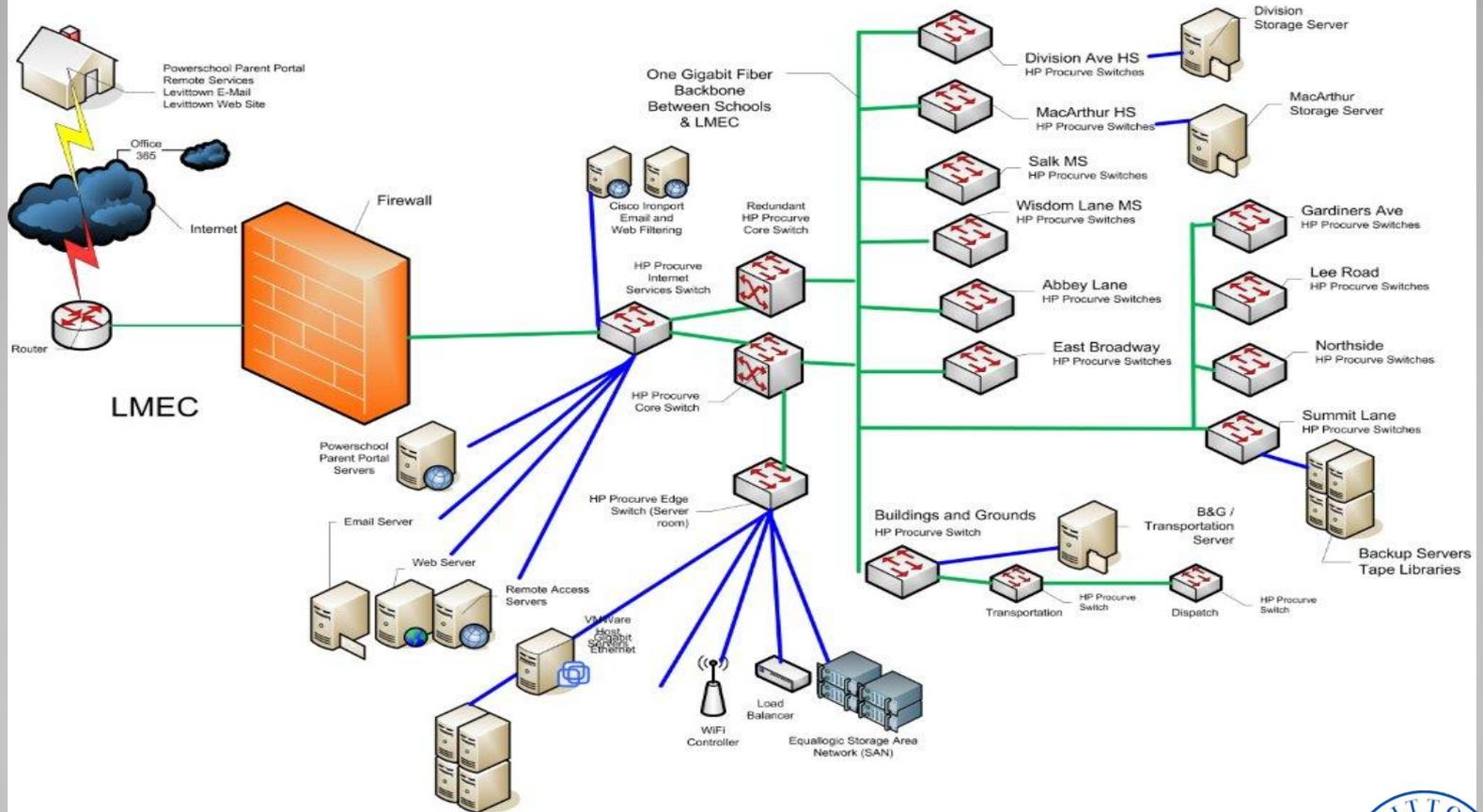

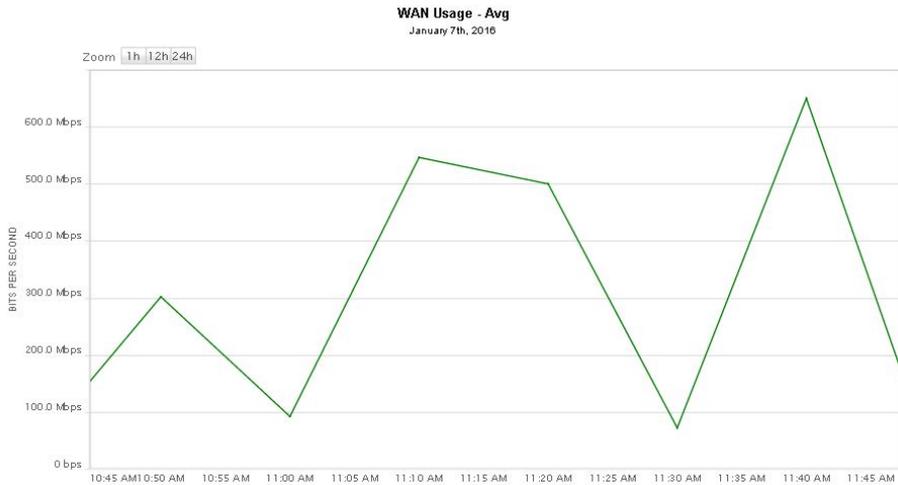
