Board of Education Adopts 2019/2020 Budget

The Board of Education adopted the proposed 2019/2020 school district budget at an open meeting on March 27, 2019. The \$222,353,639 budget represents a 2.99% budget increase and a tax levy increase of 1.97%, which is within the tax levy limit.

In January 2019, the Board of Education began hosting a series of public workshops to review the financial status of the school district and to create a budget for the coming year. This was to continue to provide excellent academic, fine arts and athletic programs for our students while maintaining fiscal stability and accountability, not only for next year, but for the years to come.

Below is an outline of some significant items that impacted the budget development process.

Board of Education Goals

As the emotional and social well-being of our students is an important element for their development, the Board makes as its goal to enhance the emotional and social literacy of students by reviewing the following programs offered by the Levittown School District throughout the coming year: Alcohol and Drug Prevention, Bullying Prevention and Outreach and Community Involvement.

As the appropriate use of data is important to the development of a well-rounded course of education, the Board will review the school district's use of data in all facets of the district's work.

As it is important that a positive message be communicated to a large number of community residents, the Board tasks the district administration to review the district's policies and procedures with respect to social media.

As financial and fiscal security is essential to the future well-being of the district and the community, the Board will develop, in conjunction with the District Administration, a sound budget that is within the tax levy limit.
