As financial and fiscal security is essential to the future well-being of the district and the community, the Board makes as its goal to develop, in conjunction with the District Administration, a sound budget that is within the tax levy limit

## **Budget Planning Calendar**

#### December, 2020

- Administrators meet with Central Office to discuss proposed budget
- Salaries are projected and incorporated into the working budget
- Preliminary health care and retirement costs are projected and incorporated into the working budget

#### January, 2021

- Draft of budget submitted to Superintendent for review/comments/changes
- January 13, 2021 Present the first draft of the 2021-2022 Budget & Budget for Transportation Department
- January 27, 2021 Present the second draft of the 2021-2022 Budget and Facilities & Operations Budget

#### February, 2021

- Continue to review, update and refine the budget
- February 10, 2021 Present the third draft of the 2021-2022 Budget and Preliminary Revenue and Tax Cap Calculation. Tax Levy Limit Calculations must be uploaded to Comptroller's Office by March 1st
- February 26, 2021 Present Curriculum and Instruction Budget & Present Special Education Budget

## **Budget Planning Calendar**

#### March, 2021

- Continue to update budget, including staffing and benefits
- March 10, 2021 Present fourth draft of 2021-2022 Budget and Staffing and Enrollment, Five-Year Projections and Fund Balance Projection; PTA Advisory Committee presentation on the budget
- March 24,2021 -Review final budget for Board adoption
- Tax Levy Limit Calculations must be uploaded to Comptroller's Office by March
   1st

#### April, 2021

- By April 23, 2021 Property Tax Report Cards due to Education Department
- By April 28, 2021 Budget Statement and required attachments must be made available to public (hard copies in the schools, Levittown Library and Levittown Memorial) in hard copy and on the website

#### May, 2021

- May 5, 2021 Budget Hearing
  - Budget Notice mailed after Budget Hearing and 6 days prior to Budget Vote
- May 18, 2021 Budget Vote

## **Building the Budget**

- 1st Draft Budget to Budget Increase 3.25%
- Primary goal is always to be fiscally responsible
- Budget reflects and supports the Board of Education goals
- Look for ways to reduce expenses without impacting program
- Look for ways to RETHINK, REORGANIZE, and RECONSTRUCT
- Budget Presentations will focus on highlights and big picture
- Information that is still needed as of January 13, 2021:
  - Covid related expenses and operation for the 2021-2022 school year
  - Tax Levy Information
  - State Aid Projections and the potential for state aid cuts
  - BOCES program costs for 2021-2022 (3% estimated for 1<sup>st</sup> draft)
  - Estimated Enrollment for 2021-2022 school year
  - Staffing

## What's Included

- Program
- Personnel
- Technology
- Impact of TRS, ERS, Health Insurance (fixed costs)
- Facilities
- Equipment
- Supplies
- Transportation (Bus purchases –tied to tax levy)
- Capital money (Transfer to Capital –tied to tax levy)

- Unfunded mandates associated with state testing and state mandated curriculum changes
- Covid 19 related expenses

## **Preliminary Revenue Budget**

- Preliminary estimates concerning the Property Tax Levy Limit indicates there will likely be less than 2.00% increase based on CPI.
- New York faces its largest budget crisis in a decade
- Estimated New York State budget deficit is \$15 billion +
- Early indications are likely that State Aid could be continued to be cut for the remaining 2020-2021 school year and decreased for the 2021-2022 school year.

2020-2021: \$ 227,424,141.62

2021-2022: \$ 234,823,941.27

Year-to-Year Change: \$7,399,799.65 or 3.25%
