**PROPOSITION NO. 1:** “BE IT RESOLVED, that the School District budget for the school year 2014-2015 proposed by the Board of Education in accordance with Section 1716 of the Education Law and on file with the District Clerk shall be approved and the necessary taxes be levied therefor on the taxable real property of the district.

**PROPOSITION NO. 2:** “BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Levittown Union Free School District (“District”), be hereby authorized to expend from the District’s Capital Reserve Fund, previously established by the voters of the District, an amount not to exceed four million dollars (\$4,000,000) to undertake and perform a school building improvement project (“Project”) as described in the District’s Budget Brochure (“Brochure”) on file in the office of the District Clerk, said Project to commence during the 2014-2015 school year and to consist of capital improvements, renovations and/or alterations to all District buildings, including but not limited to: masonry phase 2 (repointing/replacement/chimneys, environmental testing, architect and contingency), playground at Abbey Lane, Division Avenue

weight and locker rooms, Salk locker and wrestling rooms, cooling stations District-wide; including necessary equipment and related work, as well as preliminary and incidental costs; and that the specified Project costs as set forth in the Brochure may be reallocated among the Project's components within the scope of this authorization.
