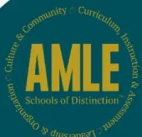

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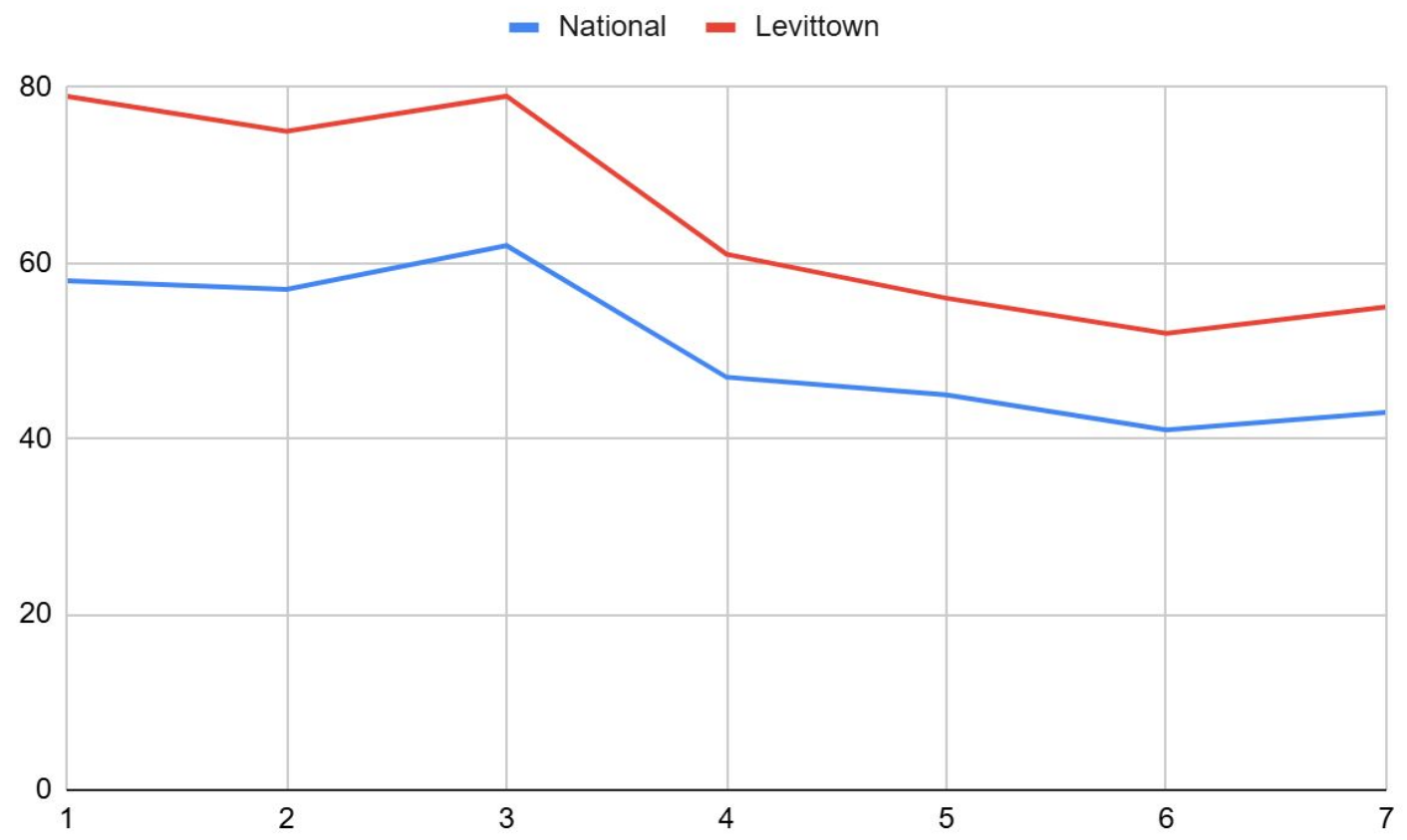

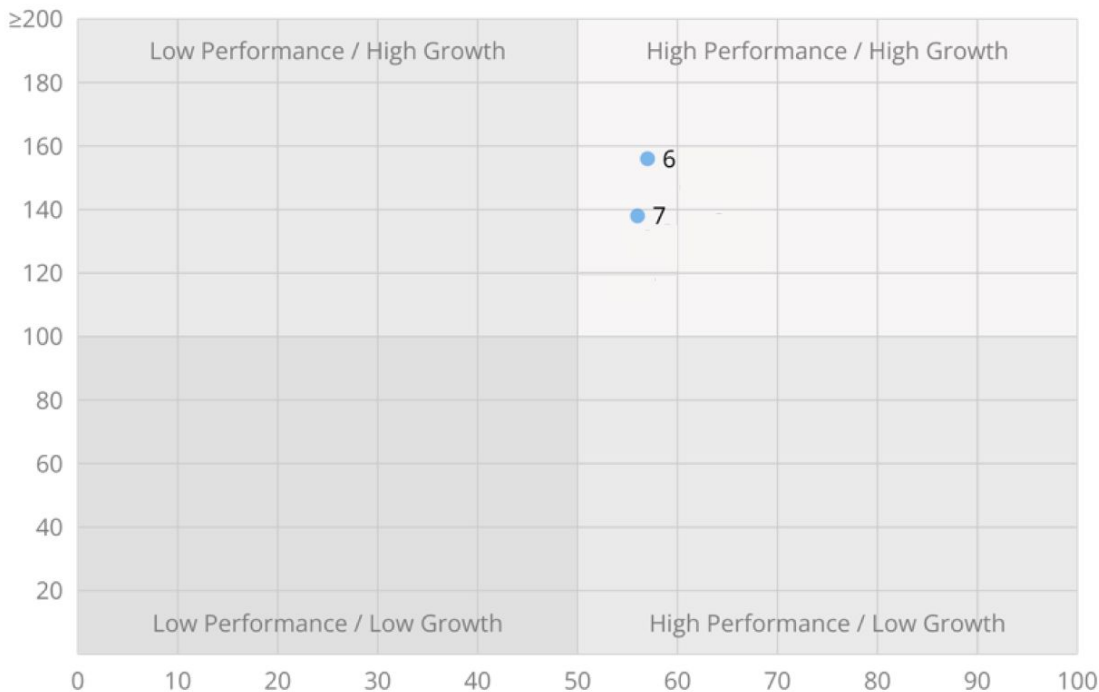

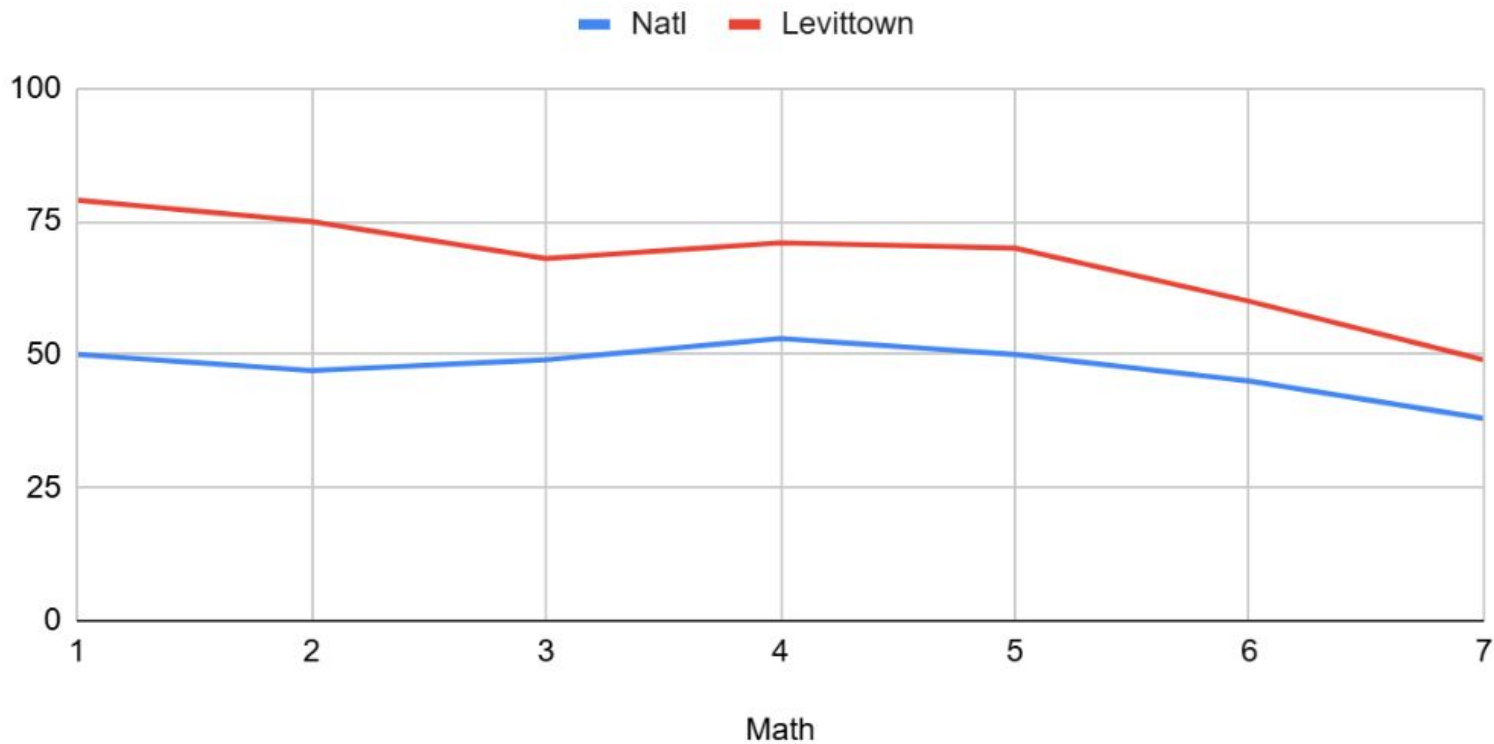

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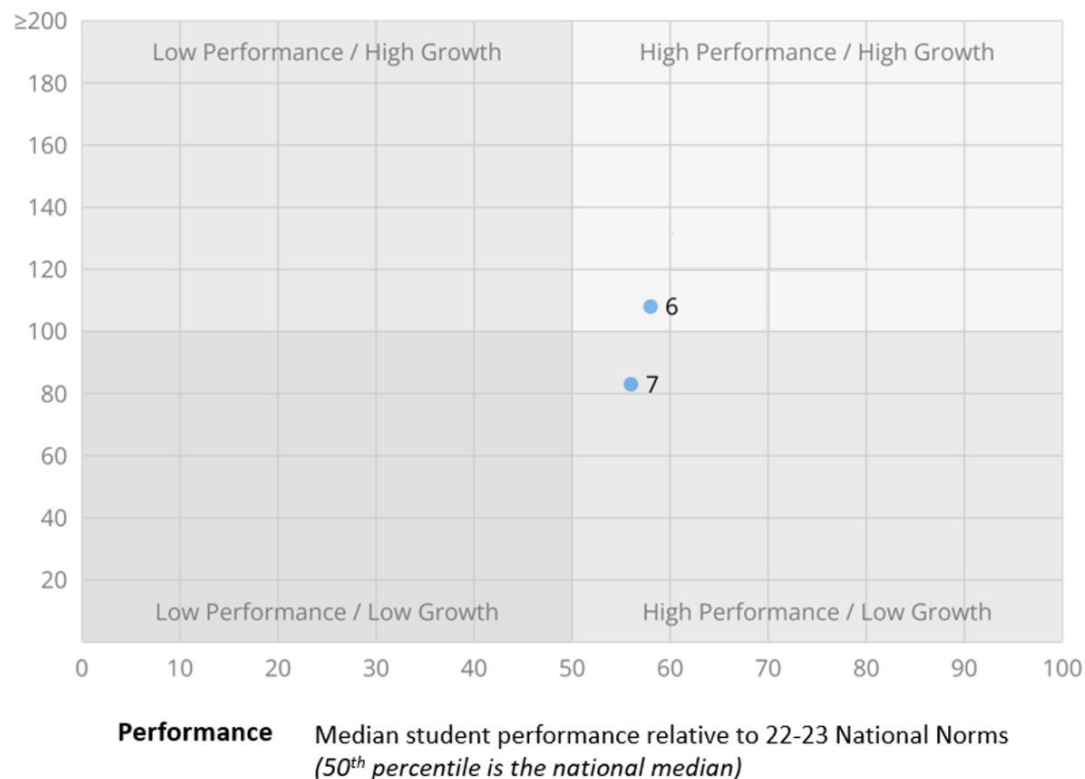


How Did Students Across the District Grow From Fall to Spring?

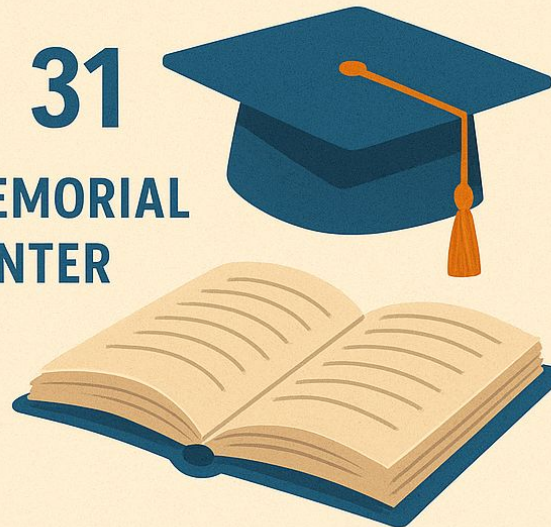

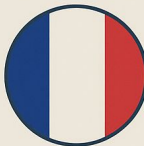
