

LEVITTOWN UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT Policy 1520

SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

Special meetings of the Board of Education shall be held on call by any member of the Board of Education. A reasonable and good faith effort shall be made by the Superintendent of Schools or the Board President, as the case may be, to give every member of the Board of Education twentyfour (24) hour notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting. All special meetings shall be held at a regular meeting place of the Board of Education and/or in accordance with provisions of the Open Meetings Law as may be applicable.

In an emergency, the twenty-four (24) hour notice may be waived by two-thirds vote of the Board of Education.

Public notice of the time and place shall be given, to the extent practicable, to the news media and shall be conspicuously posted in one (1) or more designated public locations at a reasonable time prior to the meeting.
