COMPENSATION AND EXPENSES

No member of the Board of Education may receive any compensation for their services unless they shall also serve as District Clerk and be paid as Clerk. All members of the Board of Education may be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in representing the School District. All bills or claims for reimbursement must be itemized in reasonable detail.

Conference Travel for Newly Elected Board of Education Members

In accordance with General Municipal Law, the Board of Education, by a majority vote, may authorize a newly elected Board of Education member whose term of office has not yet commenced to attend a conference. Such conference travel shall be for official School District business and shall be made utilizing a cost-effective and reasonable method of travel.

Authorization must be by resolution adopted prior to such attendance and duly entered in the minutes. However, the Board of Education may delegate the power to authorize such attendance at a conference to the Board of Education President or Board of Education Vice President by resolution at the annual organization meeting.
