

LEVITTOWN UNION FREE SCHOOL DISTRICT Policy 4320

SUPERINTENDENT-BOARD OF EDUCATION RELATIONS

The Board of Education is accountable for all pursuits, achievements and duties of the School District. The Board of Education's specific role is to deliberate and to establish policies for the organization. The Board of Education delegates the necessary authority to the Superintendent of Schools who, acting as chief executive officer, is held accountable to the Board of Education for compliance with its policies.

1. With respect to School District goals and objectives, the Board of Education will establish broad guidelines to be observed in the development of further policy and action. The Board of Education reserves the right to issue either restrictive or general policy statements.
2. Generally, the Superintendent of Schools will be empowered to assign and use resources; employ, promote, discipline and deploy staff; to translate policies of the Board of Education into action; to speak as agent of the Board of Education; to organize and delegate administrative responsibilities; and to exercise such other powers as are customary for chief executives.
3. The Superintendent of Schools may not perform, cause, or allow to be performed any act that is unlawful, in violation of commonly accepted business and professional ethics; in violation of any contract into which the Board of Education has entered; or, in violation of policies adopted by the Board of Education that limit the Superintendent of School's authority.
4. Should the Superintendent of Schools or their designee consider it unwise or impractical to comply with an explicit Board of Education policy, the Superintendent of Schools will inform the Board of Education of that determination. The Board of Education will decide whether such judgment was warranted.
