## Reinvesting in Our Schools: Building for Today, *Planning for Tomorrow*

Levittown Schools has taken a thoughtful, long-term approach to improving our buildings and grounds. While many districts rely on bond referendums to fund large-scale projects, which often result in increased costs to taxpayers, we have been able to complete significant upgrades through careful planning and responsible budgeting without incurring additional debt.

This work is visible in every school. Learning spaces are being updated to better support students, including renovated libraries across the district, with Division Avenue High School's library scheduled next. Elementary classrooms, high school business labs, and secondary family and consumer science kitchens, have also been modernized to create inviting

learning environments. Bottle filling stations have been installed in all buildings to support student wellness and promote sustainable practices.
