Dear Parent/Guardian,

The purpose of this letter is to inform you about New York State Department of Health immunization requirements for school entry on September 4, 2020. If these requirements are not met, your child will be excluded from school. Children entering seventh and twelfth grades are required to receive an adequate dose or doses of a vaccine against meningococcal disease.

-A single dose of vaccine against meningococcal serogroups A, C, W-135, and Y (MenACWY vaccine; brand names Menactra or Menveo) should be administered to all adolescents at age 11 or 12 years.

- A single booster dose of MenACWY vaccine should be administered at age 16 years.

-The booster dose is not necessary for adolescents who receive the first dose of MenACWY at age 16 years.

-The minimum interval between doses of MenACWY vaccine is 8 weeks.

- The serogroup B meningococcal B Vaccine series (MenB vaccine) may be administered to adolescents and young adults 16 through 23 years of age, at the discretion of the healthcare provider.

-Twelfth grade students must have had the vaccine administered after the age of 16.
