Arrival

All doors will open at 9:00 AM for walkers. Please arrange for your child to arrive at that time. The doors will close promptly at 9:10 AM. All children arriving after 9:10 will enter through the main entrance and get a late pass.





Traffic

Traffic on Seamans Neck Rd can be challenging during arrival and dismissal. Please ensure you arrive on time to obtain a parking spot. Cars are not permitted in the school parking lots during these times.

**Please respect all traffic laws during arrival and dismissal. Double parking or blocking corners makes is difficult for buses to turn and causes a safety hazard for our families.



Dismissal

Dismissal begins at 3:25 PM. Parents/Guardians should be at their child's dismissal location by this time. Please be on time. Any changes to your child's dismissal procedure must be in writing to your child's teacher. Please do not email staff dismissal changes.

First day of school dismissal: Please inform your child's teacher how he/she will be picked up on the first day, i.e who is picking them up.

Arrival & Dismissal Locations

Kindergarten, Mrs. Viaino, Mrs. Kratzer, and Mrs. McCoyd's walkers will use the entrance near the kindergarten rooms at the south corner of the building.

Mrs. DeLuca, Mrs. Ciaravino/ Mrs. Whaley, 2nd, & 3rd Grade

Mrs. DeLuca, Mrs. Ciaravino/Mrs. Whaley, 2nd & 3rd grade walkers will enter/exit through the main doors on Seamans Neck Rd.





4th & 5th Grade

4th & 5th grade walkers will enter/exit via the driveway on the north side of the building.

Attendance

Students are expected to be in school and on time every day. Regular attendance can help ensure student success with both academic and personal goals. Being late or absent 2 or more days per month can impede a child's ability to learn in the classroom. Attendance is part of a child's legal educational record. During drills, we take every precaution to ensure students understand these are practice situations and not real events to alleviate any anxiety they may have.


Health and Wellness

The health and wellness of our school community is of the utmost importance. Please keep students home if they are sick and notify the nurse for each day your child is absent. You may call the **direct line to the nurse at 516-434-7428** and leave a message. Please state the child's name, grade, teacher, and the reason for the absence. Transportation

The District provides a school bus for each child who qualifies. Bus students must follow the Transportation Department's rules or face suspension or loss of bus privileges. Please note this Board of Education bus policy: "Board of Education and insurance rules permit only regularly scheduled pupils to be transported in the district's buses. Children who are not eligible for transportation cannot be put on a bus for any reason. If a child is eligible for transportation and is assigned to a specific bus, the child cannot take another bus, i.e., to another stop to visit a friend."

Please note: Students scheduled to take the bus will go on the bus unless a written note is provided indicating a change.
