ACADEMIC HONESTY						
In order to protect the integrity of examinations, teachers are instructed to alert the Head Proctor and/or a building administrator if a student is suspected of academic dishonesty. Suspect behavior may include but is not limited to, providing or copying another's test answers or work, unauthorized materials in the testing room, and using an electronic device for any reason.						
All participants involved will be permitted to finish the test but will receive a "zero" grade pending a hearing. For assessments other than exams, students must submit their own work and expect it to be verified by the classroom teacher. Penalties for academic dishonesty will be subject to grading and disciplinary action.						
NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONIC DEVICES ARE PERMITTED AT MIDTERM OR REGENTS TEST SITES						
Students are prohibited from bringing cell phones and other electronic devices into a test site where a midterm exam or NYS Regents is being administered.						
Test proctors, monitors, and school officials shall have the right to collect cell phones and other prohibited devices prior to the start of the test and to hold them until its conclusion.						
This includes breaks during an exam. Admission to the exam shall be denied to any student who refuses to relinquish a prohibited device.						
MIDTERM/FINAL EXAM POLICY						
1. Students are responsible for following their exam schedule and notifying their teacher of exam conflicts prior to the start of the exam.						
2. Regents take priority over local midterms/finals.						
3. Parents must call the Attendance Office 434-7225 to report absences during exam week. A doctor's note may be required.						
4. Make-up exams will be scheduled for excused absences only (serious illness or family emergency). Administrative approval is required.
