Hello Everyone, I can't believe we are halfway through November! This is our last meeting of 2024! Our next meeting will be held on January 13th. I just have a few items to mention:

- \* New York State has increased the payment to the state from \$2.25 to \$3.25. This increase will take effect on July 1, 2025. I will discuss this further with our executive board and PTA Council to determine whether Wisdom will need to increase our membership dues.
- \* Mr. Winch has requested that the units inform their families that the upcoming November 20th Board of Education meeting will have a public be heard portion. At this meeting, the board will discuss the possibility of armed security for Levittown Schools. It is important to note that this does not mean that armed security will be implemented immediately; there is absolutely no plan to adopt anything pertaining to this at Wednesday's meeting. The board will conduct an investigation and gather all relevant information and do their due diligence before making any decisions. It is also worth mentioning that there are as many as 15-20 school districts between Nassau and Suffolk counties, including Farmingdale, Massapequa, and West Islip Schools districts, that have already implemented armed security.

# Council Delegate Report - Samantha Stanley 11/12/24

- Adopt-a-Family is underway
- 1/7/2025 next meeting
- Mr. Winch reported that there are still paving projects taking place in the district. They should be completed soon.
- o Schools are participating in various ways for Hurricane Relief. We are partnering with Asheville City Schools Middle School
- o Driver's Ed is still very limited due to low staffing (only 2-3 instructors). They are trying to rebuild the program but until then, they will continue to prioritize by date of birth.
- Regionalization Update- a letter was sent asking state to consider changing their wording.
- Graduation Requirement changing for 2027. Moving away from Regents and into one single diploma.
- He addressed there were issues with Teacher Reacher and apologized for the inconvenience they caused. They are looking into a possible platform change in the future,
